- 1) Robert Boles (DNR) has assigned Jeff Toffer to be the new resident leader of the Firewise community at Reflection Lake.
- 2) Robert and I put together a new 5 year Firewise plan for our community which is very similar to the last 5 year plan, with the exception of installing the new DRY Hydrant by 6/30/2024. Robert will review at the lake in the Spring.

Dry Hydrant- What needs to be completed to obtain the go ahead from the County.

- (1) We need to hire Advanced Wetland Specialist to complete a study and produce a report that can be used to update SEPA and JARPA applications. Cost will be \$2,000. I am currently working with Guy Gifford of see if the DNR will cover the cost.
- (2) Department of Fish and Game. They will need to see the Wetland report as well as the specs on the Dry Hydrant screen.
- (3) Department of Ecology. They will give their approval if the water being pumped from the lake is only used to fight wild fires.
- (4) Army Corps of Engineers. They need the report to show that there is not an impact to the shoreline.
- (5) Floodplains- Requires a site plan showing the location of the Dry Hydrant as well as the dimensions of any above ground structures, (i.e. the pipe) as well as the proposed grading. Requires a \$50 permit.
- (6) The Spokane County Department of Building and Planning does not require a permit.
