A few neighbors have stripped most of the paint from the southside of the sign, as of January 6, 2026. We learned it was built by a local artist around 1991, and it had gold-leaf on the lettering. It seems to be built out of old growth redwood 2 by 4's that are laminated together. It is heavy and very solid.

We are hoping to have the prep work done in the month of January, then repainting starts.
